FIRST QUARTER (JULY 1, 2016 – SEP 30, 2016) CLAIM AMOUNTS:

- DIRECT SERVICES: \$2,348,329.60 –THIS REPRESENTS THE AMOUNT BILLED BY SCHOOLS/COOPS/CHARTERS FOR SERVICES PROVIDED SUCH AS THERAPY, PERSONAL CARE, VISION/HEARING SCREENS, AUDIOLOGY AND SCHOOL-BASED MENTAL HEALTH.
- ❖ BREAKDOWN OF REIMBURSEMENT TOTALS
 - SPEECH THERAPY - \$ 918,609.80
 - PHYSICAL THERAPY - \$ 460,258.69
 - OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY - \$ 867,759.75
 - PERSONAL CARE - \$ 19,830.86
 - SBMH - \$ 1,927.84
 - VISION/HEARING - \$ 78,807.96
 - AUDIOLOGY – \$ 1,134.70
- INDIRECT SERVICES: \$ 4,060,359.81 (THIS IS A ESTIMATE) THAT REPRESENTS THE AMOUNT GENERATED BY THE ARMAC PROGRAM. THE CLAIM IS NOT FINISHED.
- MEDICAID MATCH: \$702,150.55

WHAT'S NEW:

- AFMC (STATE CONTRACTED AUDITORS) ARE CURRENTLY PROVIDING TRAININGS STATEWIDE ON DOCUMENTATION FOR PERSONAL CARE REQUIREMENTS. THE TRAINING IS GEARED MORE TOWARD PRIVATE PRACTICES, BUT SCHOOL PROVIDERS ARE STILL INCLUDED IN THE TRAINING.
- WORKING WITH DMS ON WHAT WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ANNUAL PROGRESS SINCE THE ANNUAL REVIEW FORM HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM THE IEP REQUIRED FORMS.
